



# Le Grand Peep Show

- PUBLIC:** All ages.
- LENGTH:** Maximum 3 shows per day – 30 minutes each. Note: The show is better at night time. A 45-minute break **MUST** be scheduled between shows.
- PERFORMANCE AREA:** Outdoor & indoor  
Overall performance area - Length: 23'6 / 7.20m - Width: 18' / 5,50m- Height: 16' / 4,90m.  
Tent dimensions: Length: 15'6 / 4,75m - Width: 10' / 3m - Height: 15' / 4,60m.  
4 groups of 20 people are invited inside the tent (at the back) for a private show. 500 people and more can witness the street installation and see the finale.
- PERFORMANCE SITE:** Ideal site must be flat – no potholes, not slopes, no bumps. Street asphalt is okay. One site only. Site for the tent must preferably be in the shade.
- SET-UP/ STRIKE:** 3 hours / 1 hour 30
- LIGHTING:** We bring 3 ground row of household 25w light bulbs (18 light bulbs total); 4 blue flood lights (100w each) and 2-wire rope light sign and controller.
- SOUND:** We bring 2 powered speakers with IPOD.
- OTHER POWER REQUIREMENTS:** We require 2 dedicated circuits, under 16 amps per circuit and available on the tent site. We will use a maximum of 1500 watts. Everything we bring is 110 volts and we will have 2 transformers to change our equipment to 220 volts.
- OTHER:** For multi-day bookings, the tent is set up on the day prior to the first performance and comes down on the last day of performance.  
Security must be provided on site at all times (including at night).  
Free parking space for the duration of the engagement, for a mini-bus (length:7,2m; width:2,4m; height:2,8m).  
Presenter must provide 4 large bottles of water.  
Dressing room/area: Private room that can be locked and spacious enough to allow the two performers to easily warm up, located close to the performance site.  
2 able people to help unloading and loading the van.  
1 volunteer during the performances, to help with traffic control and security.

- ACCOMMODATION:** 1 twin room + 3 single rooms. Rooms must be non-smoking.

- OTHER:** One performer cannot eat dairy products (milk, cheese, yogurt - but butter is okay) and wheat (but rice, rice pasta, rye flour bread are okay)
